

2. Hall of Fame Award:

The purpose of the Hall of Fame Award is to honor those people who have made major contributions to NEA-Alaska as an organization.

Criteria:

- a. The nominee shall be/have been a member of NEA-Alaska during his/her career or made a significant contribution to NEA-Alaska as an organization.
- b. As a result of the nominee's commitment and effort, a significant change in education should have occurred which has had a positive and lasting effect on the teachers of Alaska.

Procedures:

- a. Locals will be asked to make the nominations no later than *November 1st* each year.
- b. Nomination forms will be available from any NEA-Alaska office.
- c. The Board of Directors shall select the recipient of the Hall of Fame Award at the November Board meeting.
- d. Not more than one recipient per year will be selected for the Hall of Fame. However, under extenuating circumstances, the Board of Directors may approve more than one recipient.
- e. The Board of Directors may choose not to select a recipient from the nominations received.

Award:

- a. The recipient shall receive a plaque.
- b. He/she shall be invited to attend Delegate Assembly to receive the award. If the recipient has no plans to attend Delegate Assembly, NEA-Alaska shall pay expenses and travel and one night's hotel accommodation unless other funds are available.
- c. A plaque listing the names of recipients of the Hall of Fame Award will be displayed in each NEA-Alaska office.
