

3. Outstanding District Practice Award:

The purpose of the Outstanding District Practice Award is to recognize school districts for practices which contribute to the quality of education provided in the district.

Criteria: The District's practice nominated for the award must meet the following criteria:

- a. There must have been teacher and/or Association involvement in developing the practice.
- b. The practice must provide meaningful support to teachers in their work.

Procedures:

- a. Nominations must be received by NEA-Alaska no later than *November 1st*.
- b. The Executive Committee shall select the recipients of the award no later than prior to Delegate Assembly.

Award:

- a. The recipient shall receive a plaque.
- b. The School Board President and Superintendent of the District receiving the award will be invited to Delegate Assembly to accept the award.
- c. A description of the practices receiving the award will be disseminated to local association presidents and local school districts.
