

5. Renowned Alaskan Award:

The purpose of this award is to recognize Alaskans who have made significant contributions in education, business, government, civil rights, or labor relations.

Criteria: The nominee must meet the following criteria:

- a. The nominee shall have a positive support for public schools.
- b. The nominee must have had a positive impact on education in Alaska.
- c. He/she may also be a recognized leader and contributor to business, government, civil rights or labor relations.

Procedures:

- a. Nominations must be received by NEA-Alaska no later than November 1st each year.
- b. Nomination forms will be available from any NEA-Alaska Regional office.
- c. The Board of Directors shall select the recipient of the Renowned Alaskan Award.
- d. Not more than one recipient per year will be selected for the Renowned Alaskan award.
- e. The Board of Directors may choose not to select a recipient from the nominations received for a particular year.
- f. The Renowned Alaskan Award will be presented at Delegate Assembly.

Award:

- a. The recipient shall receive a plaque.
- b. He/she shall be invited to attend Delegate Assembly to receive the award.
